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experimental test project in Wayne County on US 30. The intention of the experiment was to identify, which pavement style was superior in performance and more economical over equal 20 year design life specifications. The different industries were challenged to provide their optimum long-term pavement designs. The initial quote for the concrete portion was \$600,000 higher than the comparative asphalt section. This summer, just after 10 years of service, the asphalt portion of the pavement has been completely resurfaced (some additional patching and repairing work had already been done prior, some as early as five years after initial construction) due to deterioration of the drive lanes at a cost of \$1,800,000, while the concrete pavement has had no rehabilitation.
